If you already have the **ShopwithScrip** app, it is easy to transfer your account to the new **RaiseRight** app. Just go to your app store and get the free app. All your information remains the same. **RaiseRight** keeps track of your reloadable balances, and it is easy to reload many of those cards. They keep you aware of bonus scrip and you can raise even more for Unity. If you do not have the ShopwithScrip app, just go to your app store and get the free RaiseRight app.

You must contact the church office to get the Enrollment Code to ensure the donation goes to our church. Then fill in all your personal information and credit info so you can order directly. **Callings: In Search of An Authentic Life** 

Please join us on Sunday, March 26, 2023, as our guest speaker, Gregg Levoy, presents his Sunday sermon "Callings: In Search of An Authentic Life." His workshop which will be a deeper dive into his sermon will be at 12 noon and is \$30 per person.
