Unity Healing and Your Energy Centers

Unity author Emilie Cady said this: "The first step toward freeing ourselves from our troubles is to get rid of our erroneous beliefs about God and about ourselves." This is the Unity practice of releasing ("denying") beliefs that are not ultimately true in divine reality.

A VERY IMPORTANT factor in this is that for complete mind-body-soul healing, we need to completely release error beliefs (and the emotions and experiences related to them) on the deepest energetic soul levels. Otherwise, the creative substance of these things will continue to cause negative effects in our lives.

In 2018 Holy Spirit gave me new healing tools for release work. I started having spine and neck tremors when actual deep energy releases of error beliefs and trauma emotions were happening for me. I also learned how to identify which energy center (part of the soul; chakra) was releasing and what exactly was being released (super helpful for learning soul lessons). I use the same processes to help my clients grow and heal faster.

In the past five years, I've completed about 1000 hours of my own personal release work this way (the average person has many, many soul traumas to release). The result? My spiritual growth and healing have been progressing about 30 TIMES FASTER than before.

TIP: Relate a life or health problem to one of your soul energy centers. (Use my energy center model to help you. If you don't have this, I can give you a copy.) Focus on the body location of that energy center. Practice allowing deep error feelings to surface and be released from there. Ask the Divine to give you a physical sensation indicator when an actual deep release is happening.


