# Gift Card (Scrip) News

An exciting new way to order SCRIP - You can order your own gift cards from 750 companies from your phone. They will be delivered directly to you.

You will only need to download the RaiseRight app from your app store on your phone. If you already have the Shopwithscrip app, just use the same sign-in info for this new app. All of your information will transfer automatically. If you do not have the current app, just download the new app and follow the directions.

This new app is so easy. You have access to 750 companies of your choice, rather than using our previous in person method to purchase. Searching by category makes it very easy. Your app keeps track of what you have in your "wallet" ... (this is what it is called on the app). It keeps track of your cards, your reloads and your eScrip.

The church is currently raising funds through scrip from those of you who are reloading your cards, but this will give us all the opportunity to truly make a difference now even though we cannot meet in person.

Please go to your app store and download the RaiseRight app and get ready to order gift cards that will be mailed directly to you. You will also get notices when the donated percentages go up during specials.
