I had a conversation with each of the kids and collected ideas of what our dream space would look like. We didn't want it to feel like school, so we have named our new space "The Clubhouse."



Once that was settled the fun really began, implementing everyone's ideas. During the last weekend of September with the help of my husband Jake, father-in-law Dave, Amber and Ellie we started to paint clouds in the room. We wanted to get the painting done before the new carpet was installed. Once the painting and carpet was done, Jake helped me bring the vision alive, part of which was constructing a tree out of cardboard and paper.

The youth made two dozen tie-dye butterflies, along with some tie-dyed flowers that were used to inhabit the room. I found some really fun imitation fruit cushions to go over the red stools and make them more comfortable. We brought the bean bag chairs out of storage so the kids have more seating options and a cozy space to meditate in. A wonderful Lego table was donated to the classroom so that kids of all ages have a space to build and create in. When talking to the kids about what the room should have they all said snacks. Reverend Karla helped us get a water cooler for the room so we have something refreshing to go with our snacks. A shoe cubby was added to give a place for everyone to remove their shoes for a more homey feeling. Some potted plants bring life to the space.

Another part of this goal was that I wanted to start setting up our lessons to follow the flow of Reverend Karla's services. We installed a TV so that I could have power points for our lessons.

If you already have the **ShopwithScrip** app, it is easy to transfer your account to the new **RaiseRight** app. Just go to your app store and get the free app. All your information remains the same. **RaiseRight** keeps track of your reloadable balances, and it is easy to reload many of those cards. They keep you aware of bonus scrip and you can raise even more for Unity. If you do not have the ShopwithScrip app, just go to your app store and get the free RaiseRight app.

You must contact the church office to get the Enrollment Code, to ensure the donation goes to our church. Then fill in all your personal information and credit info so you can order directly. They let you know which are directly mailable and which ones must be sent to the church.


