I called Joe Forand Unity San Diego's "Living Treasure" because he knew every mechanical aspect of our campus and helped to keep everything in working order for many years.



Joe was already a fixture at USD when I arrived around 47 years ago. He was a quiet and gentle soul, volunteering most week days and Sundays, doing whatever needed doing. He served as head usher for many years, and ensured that the Sanctuary was tidied up and the pews restocked after every service. He kept the organ and carillon in fine repair, including changing the carillon songs for holidays. He radiated an aura of peace and it was a blessing to be in his presence.

A very private person, Joe didn't talk about himself unless asked; and, if asked, would answer briefly and then change the subject. I know that he had a troubled childhood; that he left home at age 14 and went to work. He served in the armed service, but I don't know which one. After his discharge, he worked as a machinist, taking delight in rebuilding automobile engines.

Joe celebrated his 100th birthday on May 12, 2022. He made his transition two days after his 101st birthday on May 14, 2023. I take comfort in knowing that all the engines in Heaven will be kept in good running order.
