Letter from Cathie Robertson, Board President

As you know by now, Reverend Blair is retiring. The board has known this for some time and have been working on your behalf to make this transition as smooth and positive as possible. We are fortunate that Reverend Blair has given plenty of time to prepare for this change.

Since we knew this was coming, it was decided that we would follow Unity Worldwide Ministry's vision and move from Minister centric to mission centric church. Unity calls this the thriving ministry model, which starts with a commitment to the well-being of the church. Simply put, it moves from the "parenting" by a minister to "partnering" with one, in order for members to have a greater feeling of ownership consciousness and then the church grows in operational coherence.

We have some good ideas which are already in the works and we are open to more suggestions, so let anyone on the board know your ideas. We will be celebrating Blair and Meredith on Saturday, June 23rd, to wish them well on their new journey. Tickets will go on sale in early March, so please join us!
